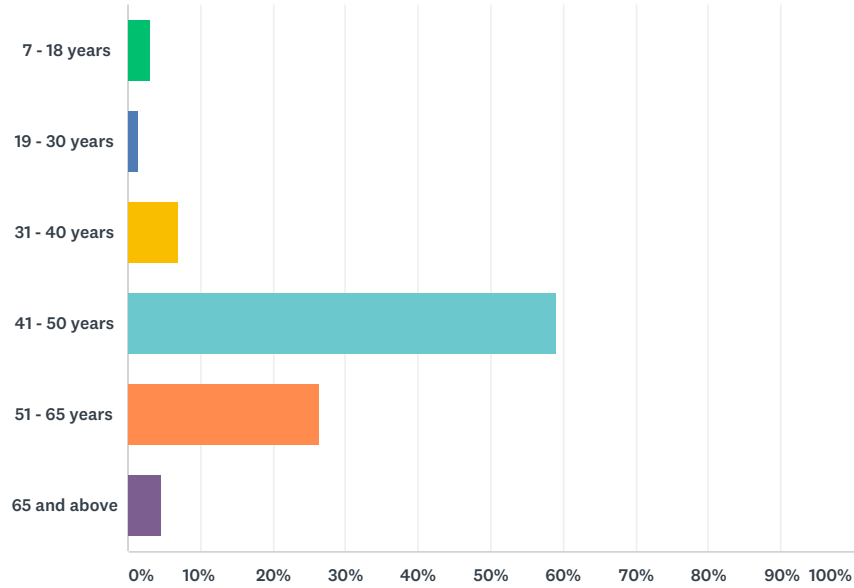

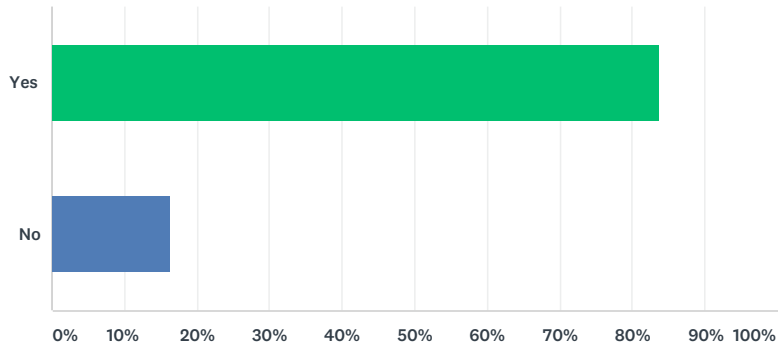

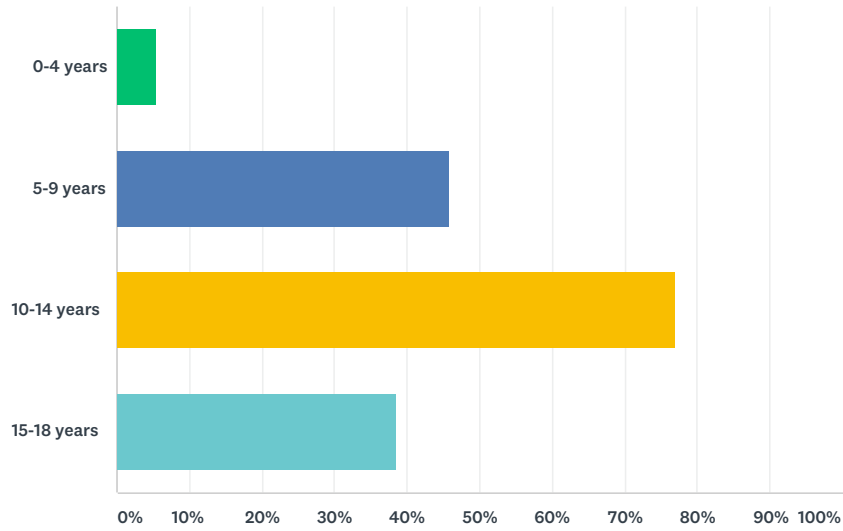

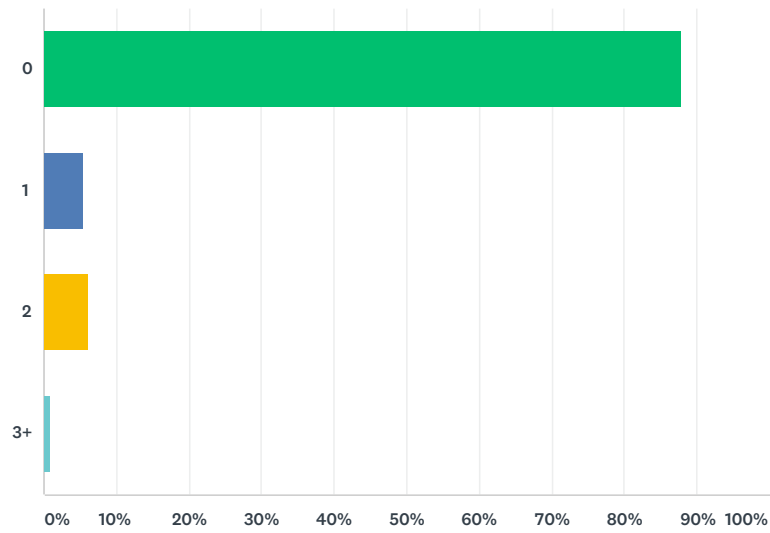

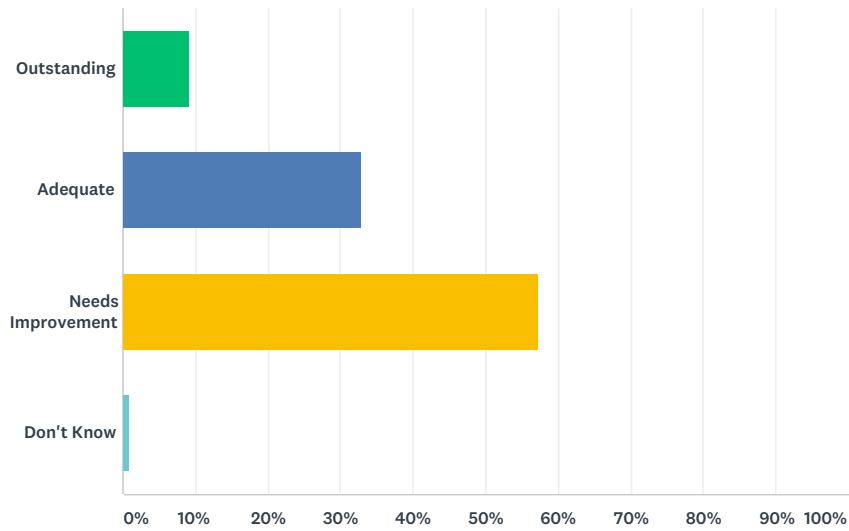

Q8 How would you describe the overall quality of public recreational facilities in Manchester-by-the-Sea?

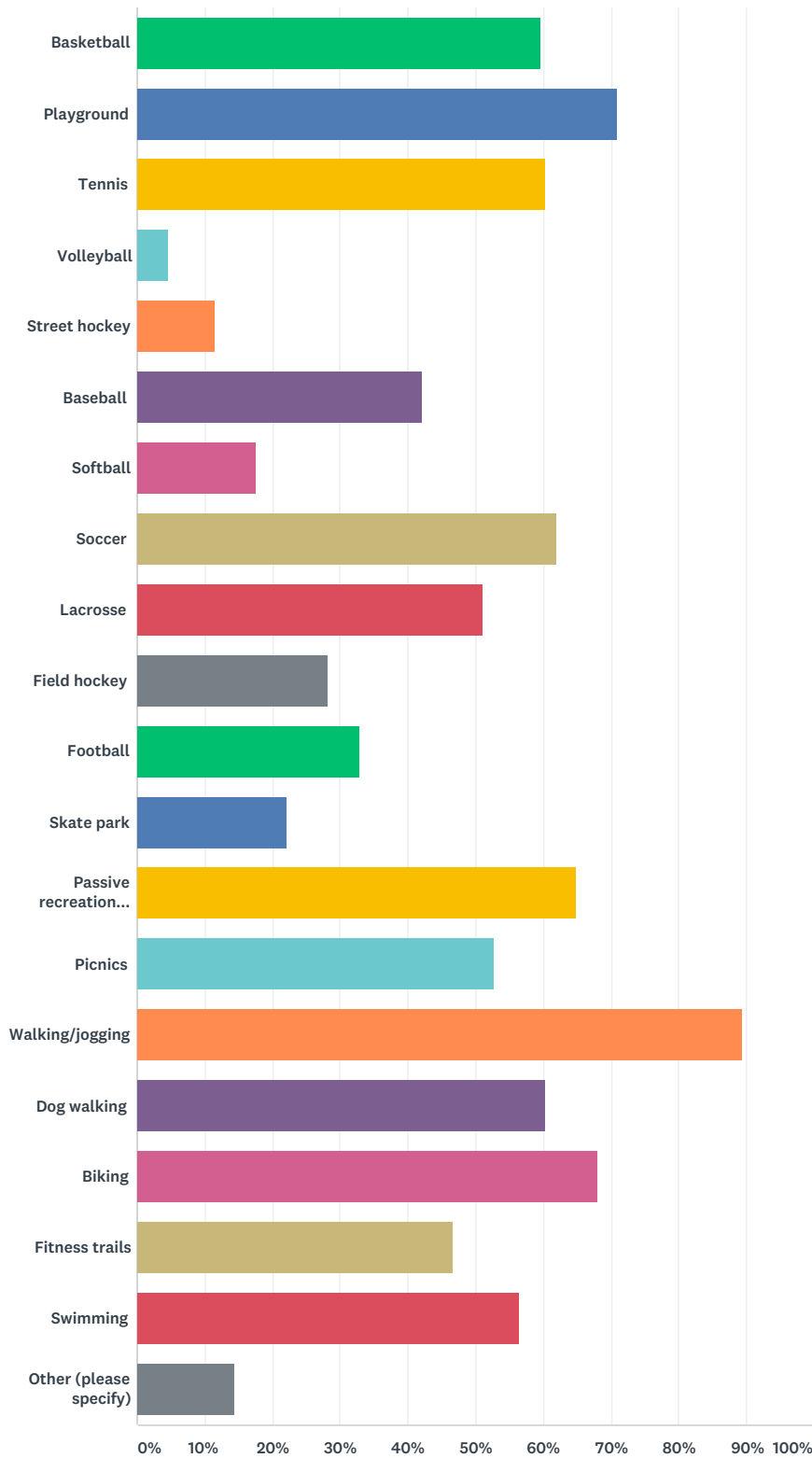

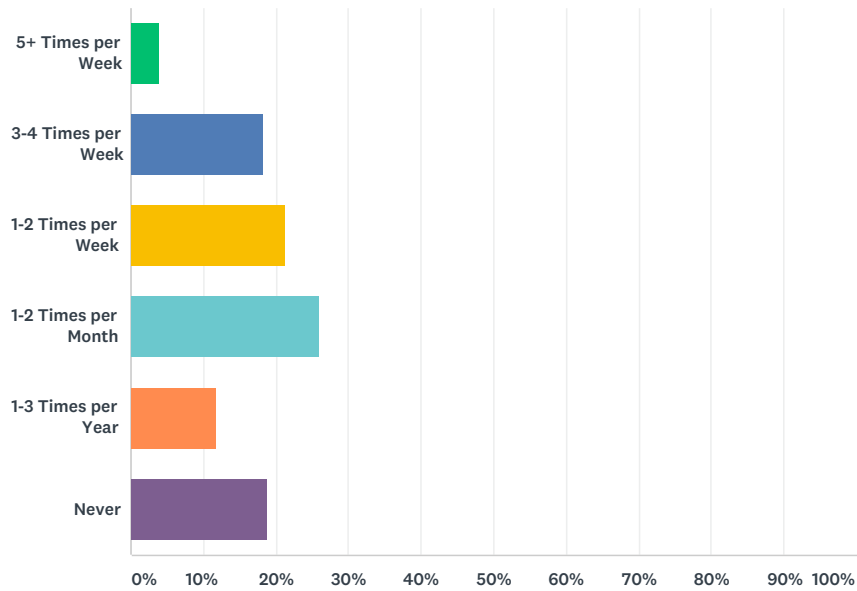

Q22 How often do you go to other towns to access recreation facilities that are not available/always occupied in Manchester-by-the-Sea?

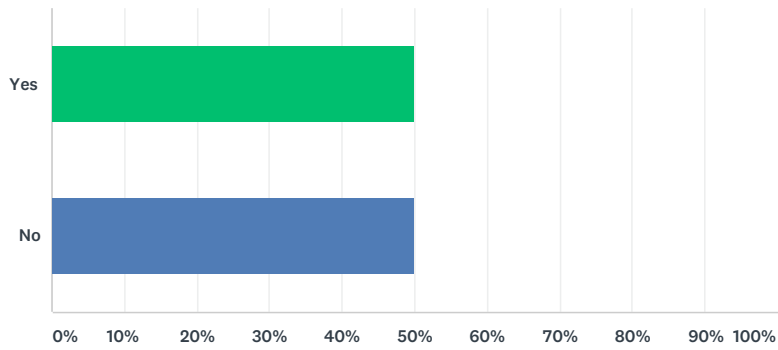

Q23 Are facilities adequate for individuals with disabilities or special needs?

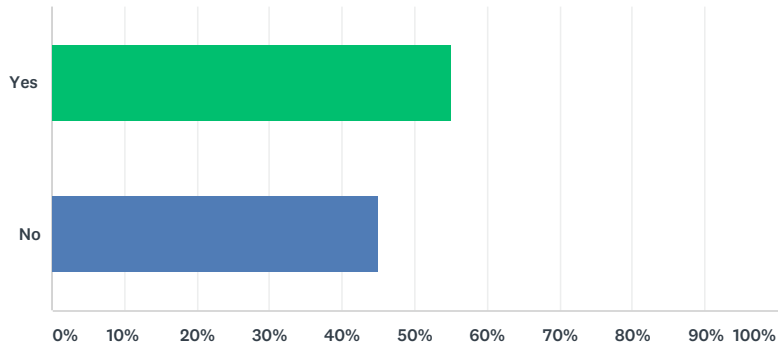

Q24 Are facilities adequate for individuals over 65 years of age?

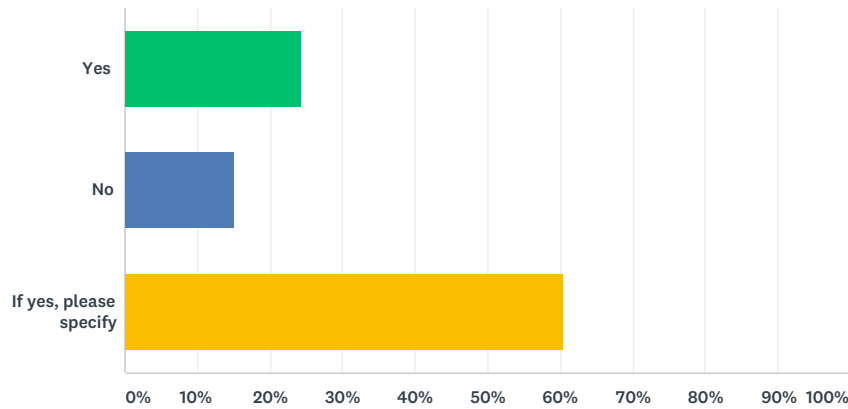

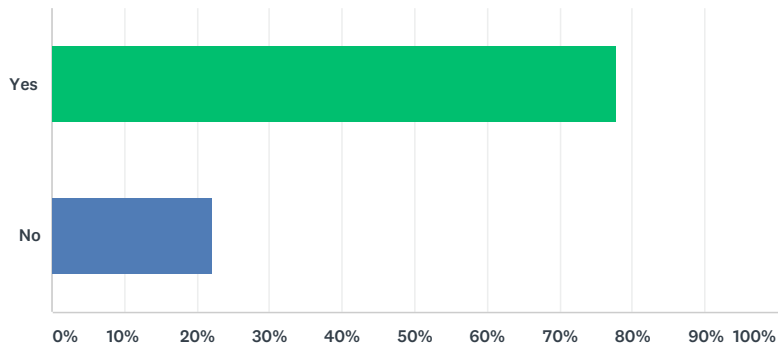

Practicing on 1/7 of coach's field can't teach them to love the game, nor can it condition or train them for skills needed for full field play. Similarly, flag football has a huge following in MBTS, but kids participate on a Hamilton team because there isn't space to play and practice here. That said, they attempt to cram practices onto Sweeney in the fall (which ultimately damages the field). Similarly, lacrosse has a growing following but again kids are being driven out of town to play. Residents have spent countless hours trying to find a way to form Manchester lacrosse teams but field space is always the nail in the coffin.
