



Manchester-by-the-Sea Phase I Reopening Guidelines: Parks & Beaches

Effective May 9, 2020

Phase I: Maintain a physical distance of 6 feet from others.
Face coverings are required in public spaces per Governor's order.

Masconomo Park

- Park is open to walkers only. No picnicking, sunbathing or sporting activities.
- Parking lot is open to residents and commercial fishermen with placards only. Resident sticker required.
- Playground will remain closed because it is a high touch area.
- Morss Pier - Open for commercial operations and Boat Club only, no recreational boater access. No congregating. Maintain a distance of 6 feet apart.
- All non-resident Boat Club members should request a "Boater Placard" through the Town Clerk and should park in the designated area behind Town Hall.
- 2 hour parking along Beach Street from Train Tracks to Tappan Street.
- Strict enforcement of parking rules and regulations. Electronic signage will be used.

Reed Park

- Park is open to walkers only. No picnicking, sunbathing or sporting activities.
- Docks closed to the public. They are open to First Responders only to gain access to Public Safety Boats.
- No recreational docks installed.

Tucks Point

- Park is open to walkers only. No picnicking, sunbathing or sporting activities.
- Bathrooms remain closed.
- Swing set is closed because it is a high touch area.
- Parking lot is open to residents and mooring holders with placards only. Grass parking area is closed. Strict enforcement of parking rules and regulations. Electronic signage will be used.
- Docks and access ramps will reopen week of May 11, 2020 due to ongoing construction. Upon opening, the dock and access ramps are reserved for dinghy access, pick-up and drop-off of passengers, and gear only. No vessels may be tied to the dock whether tended or untended for any purpose other than the immediate boarding or discharging of passengers. No congregating. Maintain a distance of 6 feet from others.
- Non-resident Manchester Yacht Club members must park on MYC property (when club reopens).

Town Hall Boat Ramp and Dock

- Boat ramp is open.
- Town docks and access ramps are reserved for dinghy access, pick-up and drop-off of passengers and gear only. No vessels may be tied to the dock whether tended or untended for any purpose other than the immediate boarding or discharging of passengers. No congregating. Maintain a physical distance of 6 feet from others.
- Parking rules will be enforced as posted.
