

Winthrop Field Committee Meeting, February 26, 2022 via Zoom

Present: Chair Mike Chapman, Tony Leggett, Gar Morse, Mike Carvalho, Matt Brzezinski, and Sue Thorne

Mike called the meeting to order at 8:30 am

Minutes from the January 8, 2022 meeting were approved as presented and will be filed with the Town Clerk.

The meeting with Mike DeRosa to assess the ponding and water infiltration issues behind 131 and 135 Bridge Street has been postponed due to weather conditions until March 3. Concerns over increased water inflow coming from Jersey Lane and increased water at the East end of the field (former Rossi property) will be discussed at that meeting. New septic installation (likely at the end of March) at the Morse's property may also provide insight to increased water inflow. A chlorine study of the water inflow behind #135 Bridge Street may indicate the source of water infiltration from new piping recently installed by the Town.

Mike reported that the Community Preservation Committee has met and has given unanimous support to the WFC request for \$10K to support the work regarding the manhole replacement work. The request will appear on the Town Warrant and will need voter approval at Town Meeting scheduled for late April.

The next meeting is scheduled for March 19, 2022 at 8"30 via Zoom.
