

## How do they feel about the Town and future changes?

Respondents were asked to indicate their level of agreement/disagreement with a series of statements. Here are some of the responses:

69% agree "Overall, I am satisfied with municipal services."
61% agree "I support prioritizing access to our beaches and harbor for residents and limiting any additional access for non-residents."
60% agree "I support encouraging more non-residential growth as a means of expanding the town's tax base to fund public facilities and infrastructure."
51% agree "I support funding public facilities and infrastructure with proposition 2 1/2 tax overrides as needed."
47% agree "The Town should support the private development of affordable housing for low and moderate income households."
