QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

QUESTIONS BY: NORTHERN TREE SERVICE

Q1: "Contractor is responsible for ordering police details.. Need and cost not to be considered in bid. DOES THAT MEAN MBTS COVERS COST?"

A1: Contractor is responsible for ordering and paying police details but should not be included in the bid; police invoices will be submitted for reimbursement on contractors invoice to the Town.

Q2: "Stump Grinding
IS CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVING CURBING AND PAVEMENT AROUND THE STUMP? IS CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBLE FOR LOAM AND SEED?"

A2: Removing curbing and pavement should not be considered in the bid. Contractor is not responsible for loam and seed.

Q3: "Estimated Quantity
THERE ARE 3 DIFFERENT DIAMETER TREES LISTED ON BID FORM. ESTIMATED QUANTITY IS 5 EA. DOES THIS MEAN PRICE PROVIDED ON A TREE WILL BECOME A UNIT PRICE USED AT OTHER LOCATIONS BASED ON DIAMETER?"

A3: Refer to paragraph 4 of Section 2 "Scope of Work".
