Step 2: On **Saturday, April 17th** start **Composting**, **Recycling**, **Repurposing**, and **Reusing**.

Step 3: On Saturday, April 24th bring your trash bag down to the American Legion parking lot from 9:00 to 11:00 to be weighed.

Step 4: The household with the lowest weeklong trash accumulation will receive the honor of being Manchester-by-the-Sea's Zero Waste Champion! The official winner will WIN a family gift card to Seven Seas Whale Watching trip!!!! All children involved in the contest will receive a coupon for a free cone at Captain Dusty's, craft kit to make a bird feeder and a bag of either flower or vegetable seeds to feed Mother Earth.
