### Changes to Beach Stickers in 2022

Manchester will move from a dual resident sticker system to a single sticker in 2022. All residents with vehicles registered in Manchester will automatically receive a single resident sticker by mail in the spring at no cost. The new sticker will allow residents to visit the transfer station, park at Singing Beach and park in resident only spaces throughout Town. Walk on passes for Singing Beach will be required for both residents and non-residents ages 12-65 and will be available for purchase starting this spring at Town Hall and online and will also be available for purchase at the beach after Memorial Day. More details will follow in the coming weeks.

### Winter Parking Ban

A winter parking ban will begin at midnight tonight. The blue lights have been activated to remind residents that on street parking is not allowed during this time to allow DPW to clear roadways.
