Local Indoor Mask Mandate Expires

Today the Manchester Board of Health voted to lift the local mask mandate at all businesses and public spaces effective **Friday, February 11**. The decision was made in response to a decline in COVID cases and is based on metrics adopted by the Board in December 2021.

The Board advises residents to continue using caution and mask if you have recently tested positive for COVID, are immunocompromised or in large crowds. The Board of Health will continue to regularly review COVID data.
